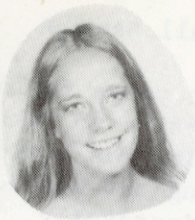
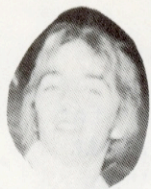

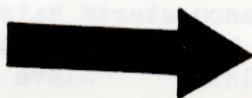

The first JV game was Saturday Nov. 25 here against Deland-Weldon, we won 42-39.

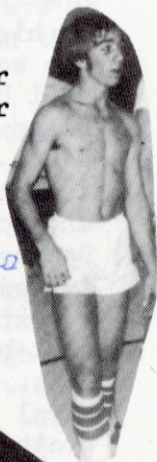
The first freshmen game was Monday Nov. 27 against Clinton, we won again 56-32.
