## Girls Intramural Basketball

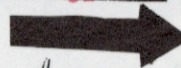
This year at Maroa-Forsyth High School the school system decided to let the girls of the school show their fantastic basketball abilities.

It was baked at the Pizza Inn, Little Rock, Arkansas.

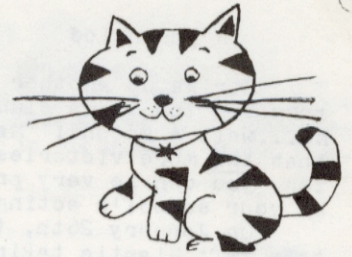
